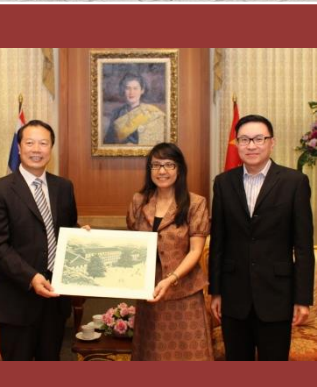
MUST Administrators' Visit
