

## Qualifications and Registration Requirements

- 1. An applicant must fill the registration form and attach one-inch photo taken not more than six months prior to application date
- 2. An applicant must be an undergraduate student studying in the third or fourth year, or a graduate student
- 3. An applicant must submit all required documents;
  - 1) Verification of undergraduate or graduate study including the most recent official transcript and a confirmation letter from your institute
  - 2) Curriculum Vitae
  - 3) Copied of passport
  - 4) Verification of English proficiency (TOEFL, IELTS, TOEIC, etc.)
  - 5) The medical certificate in English that he/she is in good health with no infectious or contagious disease
  - 6) An essay -minimum 1,000 words- explains Sustainable Economic Development in your definition. Provide examples of this concept based on your country.
  - 7) Two-minute selfie video to present yourself and your essay
- 4. An applicant must prepare a national costume for a performance at a reception party
- 5. Deadline for application submission is 28 FEBUARY 2018
- 6. An applicant must send the registration form including all required documents by email. Please send scanned all required documents and combine them into 1 PDF file and rename it in the following format; Country.Name to nidasummercamp@nida.ac.th
- 7. An Applicant will be considered based on the quality of a written essay and personal academic record
